

## Don't Throw That Away! - Collage Techniques with Sophie Newell

### Supplies

- ☐ Yes Paste
- ☐ Acrylic medium
- ☐ Scissors
- ☐ X-acto knife
- ☐ Cutting mat
- ☐ Breyer
- ☐ Paper (100-300 lb e.g. watercolor or bristol)
  - ☐ 6 sheets size 5"x7"
  - ☐ 1-2 Pads size 11 x 14 or 9 x 12 (You will need around 30 sheets total). Feel free instead to bring an assortment of sizes and thicknesses
- ☐ Brushes
  - ☐ At least 2 cheap brushes for use with glue
  - ☐ Several brushes suitable for acrylic
- ☐ Acrylic paints for Day 2 activity (A basic set. They don't need to be super high quality and no specific colors needed)
- ☐ Cup or jar for water
- ☐ Metal ruler
- ☐ Foam adhesive squares or circles (like the type used for scrapbooking)
- ☐ Ziplock bags, various sizes to store scraps
- ☐ 1 or 2 reference photos for Day 2 activity (I will bring an assortment of images if you'd prefer to use one of mine)
- ☐ An assortment of photographs, papers and materials that you're drawn to. E.g. Magazines, books, old photographs, patterned paper. There are some great stores on Etsy that sell old and interesting materials - try searching for 'ephemera', or 'photos lot'
- ☐ \*Optional\* A small assortment of art materials that you like to use, e.g. color pencils, graphite, charcoal, watercolor. Anything else you'd like to collage with/on - I love to see people experiment!
