Materials List

- Sketchbook + pens or pencils
- Water container
- Scissors
- Synthetic or bristle "bright" brushes- 1/2", 1", 2"-inexpensive Liquitex Freestyle brushes work fine; (watercolor brushes will not work!)
- Fluid Acrylic Matte Medium
- Acrylic Matte Soft Gel Medium
- · Golden or Liquitex Acrylic Heavy Body Paints small tubes or jars-
 - · cadmium yellow light or hansa yellow light
 - cadmium yellow medium or hansa yellow medium
 - ultramarine blue
 - pthalo blue green shade
 - · cadmium red medium or napthol red light
 - quinacridone magenta
 - larger tube or small jar of titanium white; bring other favorite colors you like if you have room to carry them.
- Paper towels or rags
- Pad of disposable palette sheets or parchment paper for mixing paint.
- 2-4 Painting surfaces- canvas, canvas panels or gessoed boards— 16" × 20" or larger; consider bringing different shapes such as squares.
- · Painting clothes, apron or shirt to protect clothing plus disposible gloves if you prefer
- I will bring mixed media tools—(stencils, color pencils, water soluble crayons, mark makers like brayers)

- Clip a few pictures from magazines that depict flowers and/or still life with colors or compositions that you love and/or take photos on your phone. Jot down the painters you love so you will have some inspiration for your paintings to begin with.
- Bring a few papers for collage to share with everyone! (newspaper, wrapping paper, origami, letters etc. anything goes!)

*I will bring lots of mixed media tools & papers (scrapers, collage paper, crayons, pencils, etc.) for you to experiment with but you can bring some of these if you have them.
