We will also talk about color composition and design elements of mixed media, as well as different ways of utilizing a focal point in your compositions. We will learn how to embellish our work. Then, we will put all our new collages into two totally different yet equally gorgeous handmade books or art journals. We will also create custom-printed envelopes with mini collages on the cards, which is a great gift idea. If time allows, we will make a unique, handwoven art tapestry using our collage paper.

We will be busy and learn a lot, but we will also have fun. We have the most beautiful room with a view in which to make our beautiful mess. I know we will get to know each other, forge new art connections and friendships, and share stories while listening to great playlists that will get your artistic mojo going and enhance your creative experience.
